Lifting Our Eyes: How to Fix Our Attention on Jesus

We look at our newsfeed. We look at our investments. And on average, we look at our phones over 150 times a day. But what if there were a biblical path we could follow out of chronic distraction and into a place of gazing on the One who made and loves us? How might practicing the three essential steps of moment-by-moment communion with God transform how we see God? And how might it change our perception of how He sees us?
